Gold is used for Cub Scouting, green is for Boy Scouting, Varsity Scouting is brown, red is used for Venturing and blue indicates adult service. Scouts and leaders with tenure as Tiger Cubs prior to 2000 may wear a service star with an orange backing [11] Those who served in the Exploring program prior to 1998 may wear a service star with red backing.
