Film buffs might know that from 1931's City Lights onwards, he composed the scores for all of his films, and that as an old man he wrote new music for his earlier films.

The Chaplin estate controls presentation rights now, and they only allow showings with a live orchestra, playing the music Chaplin composed for the movie. They specifically disallow accompaniment by pianos and organs. So unless you plan to do this under the table, I advise you to pick a different movie.

Charlie Chaplin : Chaplin as a Composer

Chaplin always had an interest in the music for his feature films. He approved and co-compiled scores for A Woman of Paris (1923) with Fredrick Stahlberg, and with Karil Elinor for The Gold Rush (1925). However not until City Lights did he complete a full-length score – a début heard by millions around the world when the film was released.

Limelight is a 1952 comedy-drama film written, produced, directed by, and starring Charlie Chaplin, based on a novella by Chaplin titled Footlights. The score was composed by Chaplin and arranged by Ray Rasch. The film stars Chaplin as a washed-up comedian who saves a suicidal dancer, played by Claire Bloom, from killing herself, and both try to get through life; additional roles are provided by Nigel Bruce, Sydney Earl Chaplin, Wheeler Dryden, and Norman Lloyd, with an appearance from Buster Ke

The score from CHAPLIN's classic 1931 fil, "City Lights" is one of the great film scores ever. In the music - composed by Chaplin - we feel joy, laughter, sorrow and sadness - sometimes at the same moment. The full score only existed on the film's soundtrack until 1989 when composer/ arranger Carl Davis transcribed the full score and recorded it.

The Academy Award for Best Original Score is an award presented annually by the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences (AMPAS) to the best substantial body of music in the form of dramatic underscoring written specifically for the film by the submitting composer. Some pre-existing music is allowed, though, but a contending film must include a minimum of original music.

In his score for the 1942 sound version of THE GOLD RUSH, Chaplin again followed a standard template for a silent film score, mixing classical music with original tunes.

Chaplin the director is considered one of the great auteurs and innovators of cinema history. Less well known is Chaplin the composer, whose instrumental theme for Modern Times (1936) later became the popular standard "Smile", a Billboard hit for Nat "King" Cole in 1954. Chaplin was prolific yet could not read or write music.
