Traditional or "open" bariatric surgery requires a 6- to 8-inch incision and approximately four weeks of recuperation. Using minimally invasive surgical techniques in select patients, however, Cleveland Clinic bariatric surgeons can perform the Roux-en-Y Gastric Bypass procedure without opening the abdomen.

With gastric bypass surgery, first the size of the stomach is reduced by dividing it with gastric staples, thus creating a small stomach or gastric pouch (called a "gastrojejunostomy") at the upper part of the stomach. 2.

Adjustable gastric banding surgery, often referred to by the brand name Lap-Band, is a restrictive surgery that works by decreasing the amount of food that is able to be consumed before feeling full. During gastric banding surgery, a firm silicone band with an inner inflatable ring is placed around the stomach to slow the passage of food from the upper portion of the stomach to the lower portion.
