The gerund is often confused with the present participle. That's because the gerund looks exactly like the present participle; they both are formed by adding "ing" to the verb. Look at how the word is being used in the sentence; if it's functioning as a noun, it's a gerund.

Remember; Stop; Try; The verb in the following example sentences is italicized, and the gerund or infinitive is bolded: I stopped smoking. (I no longer smoke.) I stopped to smoke. (I stopped someplace along the way to smoke.) He did not remember going to the store. (He went to the store, but he did not recall that he had been there.)
